Open to any centerboard or keel boat normally sailed by more than one person. The idea behind the Lady and the Tramp regatta is that those who normally don't steer in a regatta are at helm and in charge. Originally, this meant husband and wives reversing roles with wives skippering boats. However, FLYC has expanded the event to include LGBT and child/parent crews.

Lady and the Tramp is meant to be fun and social, and it recognizes and involves those who do not usually command a vessel. The "Lady" can be anyone who does not normally skipper a boat. In the Junior division, anyone under 18 can be the Lady, but the Tramp must be a parent or guardian. Typically, the "Tramp" is someone who is an experienced boat handler or crew, who is familiar with racing rules and protocols.

Because the skippers in Lady and the Tramp do not normally command racing boats, the regatta doesn't have the same competitive pressures as a normal race. The basic idea is good-natured fun sailing with someone you love.
