Spring Series Notice Of Race

February 2, February 9, February 23, March 2, and March 16 of 2019

1. Rules

1.1. All races in each series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017 – 2020 (RRS), the prescriptions of the US Sailing, the rules of the participating classes, and by series sailing instructions.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. This series is open to any boat holding a valid PHRF certificate or Portsmouth handicap and any One Design fleet with three (3) or more entries.
- 2.2. Competitors for each day's racing may enter by registering at the FLYC clubhouse before the Skipper's Meeting is scheduled to start.

3. Fees

- 3.1. Members may pay the annual Series Race Season Pass.
- 3.2. Individual races are \$10 for non-members/\$5 for members per day (pay on day of race to Race Committee)

4. Schedules

- 4.1. Registration is open to competitors on each scheduled race day.
- 4.2. A competitors meeting will be held at 1000 hours prior to the start of each race day.
- 4.3. Races are scheduled on February 2, February 9, February 23, March 2, and March 16 of 2019.
- 4.4. First warning signal will not be before 1100 each race day.
- 4.5. Three races are scheduled for each race day.

5. Sailing Instructions

- 5.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available at the competitor's meeting.
- 5.2. Sailing Instructions will be posed online one day prior to the first scheduled race.

6. Schedule of Races

- 6.1. Racing is scheduled for February 2, February 9, February 23, March 2, and March 16 of 2019.
- 6.2. Three (3) races are scheduled each race day.
- 6.3. The first warning signal will be no earlier than 11:00am.
- 6.4. Subsequent races will be after the completion of each race.
- 6.5. Classes may be started in any order.
- 6.6. No warning signal will be made after 15:00.
- 6.7. If the lake water level is projected to be below 400 feet, then the day's racing will be cancelled.

7. Racing Area

- 7.1. Racing will typically be in the FLYC circle racing area.

8. Prizes

- 8.1. There will be an awards ceremony at the FLYC clubhouse for daily prizes each race day.
- 8.2. A final series award ceremony will be held at the FLYC clubhouse following races on March 16th.
- 8.3. Boats entered in a division with three (3) or more entries in the regatta are eligible for prizes. Additional prizes will be given at the discretion of the organizing authority based on participation.
